



Albuquerque Gymnastics School, Kyle Georges and his wife, Jen, are excited to announce that Kyle will be joining the AGS coaching staff in June of this year.

Kyle Georges is a native of Albuquerque and started participating in gymnastics at the age of three. After competing for eight years he began coaching at the age of 16. While coaching he earned his degree in University Studies with a concentration in Physical Education and Communication from the University of New Mexico.

Kyle has been the assistant coach for the United States Air Force Academy women's gymnastics program for 7 seasons. He was named the top assistant coach in the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation during the 2011 season; Kyle became just the second Air Force assistant to ever claim that distinction from the conference.

During his coaching career at the Academy, Air Force has accounted for three conference champions, two USAG champions and over 50 USAG All-Americans. Also, during Kyle's time at the Academy, the team broke the uneven bar record in 2013 and 2014, a record that stood for 7 years. Kyle, who served as the lead coach on the uneven bars for four seasons, guided Linnaea Hance to the national title on that event at the 2014 USAG Championships.

Kyle has also worked several sports camps over the past several summers, to include Denver University, Rocky Mountain Training Camp, and Region 3 High Performance Camp. He was the 2015 & 2016 USAFA Camp Director. For the past six years, he attended J.O. Nationals and traveled around the country to successfully recruit athletes to the Division I level.

In addition to his coaching duties at Air Force, Kyle taught several physical education classes at the Academy. These classes included racquetball, rock climbing, water survival, and scuba diving. He was named the USAFA Department of Physical Education's Civilian Instructor of the Year in 2016 and earned the Air Force Athletic Department's Aquatics Instructor of the Semester Award in the Fall of 2015. Kyle was active with the NCAA and was the North Central Regional Score Verification Coordinator for four years.
